1. ___ Your educational level is at Low Secondary or High Secondary. Educational level _____
(MN Dept of Education requires pre/post tests to determine this level)
2. ___ You have prepared for the GED by using one or more of the following test preparation strategies:
 - studied the GED workbooks and other prep materials
 - completed the unofficial GED practice tests on the computer or in GED study books
3. ___ You have successfully completed the official GED practice tests. (See chart below)
These practice tests are an indicator of your success on the Final Tests.
4. ___ You have attended ABE classes for a minimum of **12 hours**. Besides number 2 and 3 above, GED candidates can also obtain attendance hours by researching careers and improving computer skills.
